

**IRON RIVER CITY COUNCIL
SPECIAL MEETING
WEDNESDAY, MAY 16, 2001
1:00 P.M.**

The meeting was called to order at 1:00 p.m. in the Legion Room of the Iron River City Hall, with Mayor Charlotte Soderbloom presiding.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Members present included Councilman Alfred Perlongo, Ray Coates, Tom Beber, Mayor Charlotte Soderbloom, City Attorney Mark Tousignant and City Clerk Peggy Shamion. Safford was absent.

Two students from the government class also attended the meeting.

The purpose of the meeting was to discuss the proposed Sidewalk Ordinance.

Tousignant told the board that this ordinance does not require maintenance and referred to Section 3.2b.

Some councilmen were uncomfortable with having to make people pay for their sidewalks, when they are property of the city. Tousignant suggested an assessment on the tax roll for people to replace their sidewalks. He also told the board that MDOT has good sidewalk specifications.

After some discussion, Beber introduced the Iron River Sidewalk Ordinance and a Public Hearing will be set up for May 30, 2001 at 1:00 p.m.

Beber moved with Coates supporting to adjourn the meeting at 2:00 p.m. All were in favor. Motion carried.
