

**IRON RIVER CITY COMMISSION
PUBLIC HEARING
MONDAY, SEPTEMBER 17, 2001
1:00 P.M.**

Mayor Charlotte Soderbloom called the meeting to order at 1:00 p.m. in the Legion Room of the Iron River City Hall.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Members present included Councilmen Alfred Perlongo, Tom Beber, Ray Coates, Klint Safford, Mayor Charlotte Soderbloom, City Manager Rosalie King, City Attorney Mark Tousignant and City Clerk Peggy Shamion.

Others in attendance were Mike Gatzow, Tom Mayo and Bob Hagelin.

The purpose of the meeting was to receive public comment on the abandonment and vacating of the streets and alleys located in the Plat of County Fair Addition to the Village (now City) of Iron River, according to the recorded plat thereof, to wit:

- A. Hunter Street, formerly known as Washington Street, from the East right-of-way limit of Ninth Avenue, formerly known as Wilson Road, to the East boundary line of the Plat of County Fair Addition;
- B. Madison Street, from the East right-of-way limit of Ninth Avenue, formerly known as Wilson Road, to the East boundary line of the Plat of County Fair Addition;
- C. Fair View Street, from the East right-of-way limit of Ninth Avenue, formerly known as Wilson Road, northeast to the North boundary line of the Plat of County Fair Addition; and
- D. All alleys located within the Plat of County Fair Addition.

There was no public comment. However, the meeting was kept open in conjunction with the regular Iron River City Council meeting held on September 17, 2001.

Mayor Soderbloom adjourned the Public Hearing at 1:40 p.m.
