SPECIAL MEETING

9:00 A.M.**

Mayor Soderbloom called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m. in the Legion Room of the Iron River City Hall.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Members present included Alfred Perlongo, Ray Coates, Tom Beber, Klint Safford, Mayor Charlotte Soderbloom, City Manager Rosalie King, City Attorney Mark Tousignant and City Clerk Peggy Shamion.

No one else attended the meeting.

Beber moved, with the recommendation of the City Manager that Gary Pisoni be awarded the bid for surveying the Iron River Cemetery expansion. Perlongo supported the motion.

Dick Anderson's employment contract was discussed. A paragraph in the contract stated that if the Foreman job doesn't work out that Anderson could go back to the union. The union did sign an agreement stating the same. He would also be compensated a salary equal to the Chief of Police.

Safford moved to hire Richard Anderson as Foreman with a rate of pay equal to the Chief of Police. No employee agreement be drawn up but allow him if things don't work out, to be able to transfer back to the union. Coates supported the motion.

After some discussion, Perlongo moved with Coates supporting to restructure and make the same type of working agreement for all four department heads.
