

**IRON RIVER CITY COUNCIL
SPECIAL MEETING
FRIDAY, MARCH 8, 2002
2:30 P.M.**

Mayor Charlotte Soderbloom called the meeting to order at 2:30 p.m., in the Legion Room of the Iron River City Hall.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Members present included Klint Safford, Virgil Thompson, Tom Beber, Ray Coates, Mayor Charlotte Soderbloom, City Attorney Mark Tousignant, City Manager Rick Commenator and City Clerk Peggy Shamion.

Bud Hamacher, Mark Polley, Bob Hagelin also attended the meeting.

The purpose of the meeting was to consider the Iron River Township sewer agreement.

Soderbloom was concerned about the payments being kept track of. Tousignant suggested generating a bill (but not sending it) and when payment is received, checking it off. He stated that it is equally important that in June or July, when the figures are recalculated by the Sewer Authority, someone obtain this information and go back and calculate the CPI (consumer price index) to determine what the new rate will be for the following year.

Tousignant explained that this new agreement is the only one that will exist. All other agreements or arbitration rulings will be null and void.

Safford then moved to accept the new sewer agreement with Iron River Township and Beber supported the motion.

Roll Call: Ayes: 5 Nays: 0 Motion carried.

Beber moved to adjourn the meeting and Coates supported. All were in favor. Motion carried. The meeting adjourned at 2:35 p.m.
