

**IRON RIVER CITY COUNCIL MINUTES
SPECIAL MEETING
FRIDAY, AUGUST 13, 2004
3:00 P.M.**

The meeting was called to order at 3:00 p.m. in the Legion Room of the Iron River City Hall, with Mayor Charlotte Soderbloom presiding.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

The purpose of the meeting was to open bids for the Water Contingency Project. Four bids were received:

Hebert Construction - \$493,919.05 – Alternate (a) - \$53,615.33, (b) \$30,626.79, (c) \$46,281.81 and (d) \$19,636.01.

BACCO Construction - \$532,890.30 – Alternate (a) 50,044.00, (b) \$32,509.50, (c) \$55,760.00 and (d) \$23,062.50.

Oberstar Inc. - \$443,630.60 – Alternate (a) \$50,812.75, (b) \$33,071.50, (c) \$51,111.25 and (d) \$22,845.00.

Lakeland Enterprise - \$430,694.50 – Alternate (a) \$45,922.00, (b) \$26,358.50, (c) \$41,836.00 and (d) \$18,117.50.

Coates moved with Beber supporting to turn the bids over to the engineering for tabulation and award at August 18, 2004 meeting.
