

**IRON RIVER CITY COUNCIL MINUTES
SPECIAL MEETING-MANAGER EVALUATION
TUESDAY, DECEMBER 21, 2004
10:30 A.M.**

The meeting was called to order at 10:30 a.m. in the Legion Room of the Iron River City Hall, with Mayor Charlotte Soderbloom presiding.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Members present included Ray Coates, Roger Zanon, Tom Beber, Virgil Thompson, Mayor Charlotte Soderbloom, City Manager John Archocosky and City Clerk Peggy Shamion.
