

**IRON RIVER CITY COUNCIL MINUTES
PUBLIC HEARING
WEDNESDAY, MARCH 16, 2005
4:30 P.M.**

The Public Hearing was called to order at 4:30 p.m. in the Legion Room of the Iron River City Hall, with Mayor Charlotte Soderbloom presiding.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Members present included Councilmen Roger Zanon, Ray Coates, Tom Beber, Mayor Charlotte Soderbloom, City Manager John Archocosky and City Clerk Peggy Shamion. Absent was Virgil Thompson (vacation)

Others attending included Bill Leonoff and Adam Steinbrecker.

The purpose of the meeting was to receive public comment in regards to the proposed application for the Community Development Block Grant Program Funds, for deteriorated sanitary sewers along Lalley and Ice Lake Roads.

Archocosky reported that Jere Fritsche would be getting on city sewer when the project goes through.

Task Force funds will be used to reconstruct the intersection of Lalley Road and Ice Lake Road.

The total of the project is \$1,198,000 of which \$250,000 will be taken out of the DEQ account as the local match; \$768,000 is grant amount and \$180,000 will come from Task Force funds.

The Public Hearing was closed at 4:46 p.m. by Mayor Soderbloom.

Zanon moved with Beber supporting to adopt a Resolution authorizing the submission of a Michigan CDBG Application for the Lalley Road Sanitary Sewer Rehabilitation Project, and authorize the Mayor to sign all documents.

Roll Call: Ayes: 4 Nays: 0 Absent: 1 – Thompson Motion carried.

Zanon moved with Beber supporting to adjourn the Public Hearing. All were in favor. Motion carried.
