

**IRON RIVER CITY COUNCIL
PUBLIC HEARING - AMENDMENT TO PURCHASING ORDINANCE #19-2001
WEDNESDAY, MARCH 16, 2005
5:30 P.M.**

The purpose of the Public Hearing was to receive public comment regarding the amendment to the Purchasing Ordinance #19-2001.

The amendments are to Section 4 & 5. In Section 4 the amendment is to allow the expenditures by the City Manager to increase from \$700, and not to exceed \$1,000. Section 5 amendment is just some mere language changes to coincide with the amendment to Section 4.

There was no public comment, but the Public Hearing shall remain open in conjunction with the regular city meeting.

The regular meeting commenced at 5:45 p.m.

NEW BUSINESS

Councilman Beber explained that the Finance Audit Committee recommended the city become a member of the Iron County Historical and Museum Society as a business patron for \$100.

Coates moved with Zanon supporting to purchase a Patron membership for the Iron County Historical and Museum Society for \$100.

Beber moved with Soderbloom supported to adopt the Community Development Plan as presented. All were in favor. Motion carried.

Correspondence was received from Rob Possanza of the Iron River Care Center concerned about state cuts that are proposed for nursing homes and Medicaid reimbursement. He was asking that the city contact our elected officials regarding the cuts.

Zanon moved with Beber supporting to have Manager Archocosky draft a letter supporting Iron River Care Center 's program and send it to our elected officials. All were in favor. Motion carried.

Mayor Soderbloom closed the Public Hearing at 5:55 p.m.

Beber moved to adopt the amended Purchasing Ordinance #19-2001 and Coates supported.
