

**IRON RIVER CITY COUNCIL MINUTES  
PUBLIC HEARING – 2005-2006 BUDGET  
WEDNESDAY, MAY 18, 2005  
4:45 P.M.**

The Public Hearing was called to order at 4:45 p.m. in the Legion Room of the Iron River City Hall, with Mayor Charlotte Soderbloom presiding.

Council Members present included: Virgil Thompson, Ray Coates, Thomas Beber, and Roger Zanon, as well as City Manager John Archocosky, and Attorney Mark Tousignant

Virgil Thompson questioned cutting 1 mil. Manager Archocosky explained the negative effects this would have on the General Fund at the current time.

Councilman Zanon questioned the income and expenditure of the Chalet. It was determined that the income is about \$1500 and our expenditures were \$7500 to \$7800. Manager Archocosky mentioned that there has been some discussion regarding the selling of the chalet and a buildable lot that is adjacent.

Councilman Zanon questioned the excess amount under capital outlay for the police. Manager Archocosky explained that this was for the new police car, and he and Chief Goriesky hope to replace a car every other year.

There were no further comments at this time, but Mayor Soderbloom did not adjourn at this time in case there were further inquiries.

The Public Hearing portion of the meeting was adjourned at 5:30 pm.
