

**IRON RIVER CITY COUNCIL MINUTES
PUBLIC HEARING
WEDNESDAY, JULY 20, 2005
4:45 P.M.**

The meeting was called to order at 4:45 p.m. in the Legion Room of the Iron River City Hall , with Mayor Charlotte Soderbloom presiding.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Members present included Councilmen Roger Zanon, Ray Coates, Virgil Thompson, Tom Beber, Mayor Charlotte Soderbloom, City Manager John Archocosky, City Attorney Mark Tousignant and City Clerk Peggy Shamion.

Others attending included Vivian Leonoff, Rosalie King, George Treado, George Brunswick, Bernard St. Germain, Kelly & Jane Gustafson, Adam Steinbrecher, Jere Fritsche and Robert Mattson.

The purpose of the meeting was to receive input and opinions from the public regarding the proposed application for the Community Development Block Grant Program funds (CDBG), for replacing the deteriorated sanitary sewer interceptor piping between the 4 th Ave. Bridge and the City RV Park.

Adam Steinbecher of STS Consultants explained that the project will start at the WISCA interceptor and go up to the piece that the city replaced approximately two years ago.

The funds will consist of a \$445,500 grant from CDBG and \$250,000 from the DEQ reserve account.

The project will be bid next spring. The possibility of proceeding with the slip lining method may be used for the project.

There were no other comments at this time and Mayor Soderbloom asked that the Public Hearing be left open in conjunction with the regular city meeting for those people who attend later.

The meeting moved into the regular city meeting at 5:00 p.m.
