

**IRON RIVER CITY COUNCIL
SPECIAL MEETING
MONDAY, NOVEMBER 14, 2005
10:00 A.M.**

Mayor Charlotte Soderbloom called the meeting to order at 10:00 a.m. in the Legion Room of the Iron River City Hall.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Members present included Ed Marcell, Roger Zanon, Ray Coates, Tom Beber, Mayor Charlotte Soderbloom, City Manager John Archocosky, City Attorney Mark Tousignant and City Clerk Peggy Shamion.

Jack LaRock also attended the meeting.

There is some concern about a billboard sign that Kris Hughes has added to which is located on the corner of U.S. 2 and Cedar Ave. He may or may not be on city right-of-way and unless a survey is done the city really can't prove it.

There is a problem with the way the present Zoning Ordinance is written. Archocosky has asked Mr. Hughes to cease working on the sign until he can review the issue.

Tousignant explained that the state permits are separate from the city permits. The state does not allow billboard signs on state property.

Coates moved with Soderbloom supporting to put a moratorium on Land Use Permits for signs until the ordinance can be reviewed by the City Attorney. Roll Call: Ayes: 5 Nays: 0 Motion carried.

City Treasurer Suzanne Johnson and Manager Archocosky have prepared budget amendments. City Auditor Diane Rostagno has asked that the city do amendments to the budget quarterly, to be more in line to what is occurring.
