

**IRON RIVER CITY COUNCIL MINUTES
WORKSHOP
TUESDAY, JUNE 13, 2006
10:00 A.M.**

The meeting was called to order in the Council Room of the Iron River City Hall, with Mayor Charlotte Soderbloom presiding.

Members present included Councilmen Tom Beber, Ed Marcell, Roger Zanon, Ray Coates, Mayor Charlotte Soderbloom, City Manager John Archocosky and City Clerk Peggy Shamion.

No one else attended the meeting.

RECREATION PLAN

The Council had previously been appointed as the Recreation Board. They had reviewed a Five Year Improvement Schedule. Several items listed on the schedule have already been completed.

Archocosky noted that he has been in contact with Paul Malmquist in regard to the road north of Bachman Park. When the County paves their portion of the road, he is supposed to get in contact with Archocosky and it's possible the city will pave their portion of the road.

Next discussed was the Ice Lake Park boat landing & fishing ramps. Coates recalled a few years ago when several people offered to help construct the boat landing/fishing ramp. He suggested contacting those same people to see if they were still interested in doing the same project.

A few items have been listed under the 2006-2007 year for the RV Park, however, no money has been appropriated for this park.

The board asked that Archocosky compile a rescheduled list.

The board felt the bocce courts listed by Nanaimo Park for 2005-2006 could remain on the new list, but there was some concern as to if they should be built. Public interest in this project will be reviewed.

BROWNFIELD AUTHORITY

Attorney Tousignant is working on the by-laws for the new City Brownfield Authority. The Mayor and Manager will both be part of that board. The Mayor has also made a list of candidates for this board, which she will bring up at the next regular city meeting. She encouraged other board members to do the same.
