

**IRON RIVER CITY COUNCIL MINUTES
PUBLIC HEARING - CLOVERLAND
WEDNESDAY, JANUARY 17, 2007
1:30 P.M.**

The meeting was called to order at 1:30 p.m. in the Council Room of the Iron River City Hall, with Mayor Charlotte Soderbloom presiding.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Members present included Councilmen Ray Coates, Roger Zanon, Tom Beber, Ed Marcell, Mayor Charlotte Soderbloom, City Manager John Archocosky, City Attorney Mark Tousignant and City Clerk Peggy Shamion.

Patti Waite, Ron Basso and Lisa Coombs-Gerou also attended the meeting.

The purpose of the meeting was to receive public input regarding razing the Cloverland Hotel.

Patti Waite (who owns property next to the Cloverland) asked if her wall is going to be sealed. She would also like to be contacted before the building comes down so she can take care of her computer; she was hopefully that the event wouldn't take place until after April 15, due to tax season.

Manager Archocosky stated that they are not that far into the project yet but he was sure she would be contacted and advised as to when the building would be coming down.

Lisa Gerou from TriMedia said that the environmental review is moving ahead.

There was no other public comment so Mayor Soderbloom closed the Public Hearing at 1:50 p.m.

Beber moved with Marcell supporting to adopt Resolution 01-07 authorizing approval to submit application to seek funds of \$250,000 to demolish the Cloverland Hotel, and authorize John Archocosky to sign the application.

Zanon moved with Beber supporting to adjourn the meeting at 1:52 p.m. All were in favor. Motion carried.
