MINUTES**

Mayor Charlotte Soderbloom called the Public Hearing to order at 1:45 p.m. in the Council Chambers at the Iron River City Hall.

Council members present: Edward Marcell, Ray Coates, Thomas Beber, Roger Zanon and Mayor Soderbloom.

City Manager John Archocosky and Clerk Kathy Anderson were present.

Citizens in attendance: Craig Richardson and Adam Steinbrecher of STS Consultants, Reporters Allyce Westphal of The Iron County Reporter and Wendy Shimun of WIKB attended.

No other members of the public were present.

The purpose of the hearing was to receive public comment and or input on the closeout of Michigan Economic Development Corporation (MEDC) grant funding for the north district sanitary sewer project.

Steinbrecher of STS Consultants noted that the total amount granted was \$541,500.00. The City's share which included construction and engineering costs totaled \$286, 479.19, resulting in a 65% grant. Final documents will be submitted as all requirements have been met to close out the project.

As there was no public comment forthcoming, Soderbloom closed the Public Hearing at 1:50 p.m.
