MINUTES**

Deputy Mayor Roger Zanon called the workshop to order at 1:30 p.m. in the Council Chambers at the Iron River City Hall.

Absent: Mayor Charlotte Soderbloom.

The purpose of the meeting was to review the Iron County Community Hospital (ICCH) expansion plan.

City Manager John Archocosky, Attorney Mark Tousignant, DPW Foreman Richard Anderson and Clerk Kathy Anderson were present.

Iron River Zoning/Planning Board members present: Jere Fritsche, Rick Commenator and Ben Smith.

County Building Inspector Jerry Anderson and 911 Coordinator Steve Gagnea attended.

Representatives from the hospital, architectural firm and general contractors were present to answer questions and offer a power point presentation of the plan. Representatives included Bruce Rampage and Glen Dobson (ICCH), Kyal Klawitter and Kevin Kerschbaum (HGA Architects and Engineering), and Heather Staffel and Jeff Miller (Myron Construction).

Some new construction will take place, and renovations to the existing building will be made. A new canopy will be constructed at the main entry. A new emergency room will be added on the north side of the building. An addition will be constructed in the cafeteria, as well as new staff parking on the south side of the building and landscaping.

Coates moved to adjourn at 2:37 p.m. Zanon seconded. All were in favor. Motion carried.
