MINUTES**

Mayor Charlotte Soderbloom called the meeting to order at 1:30 p.m. in the Council Chambers at the Iron River City Hall. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Roll Call: Edward Marcell, Ray Coates, Thomas Beber, Roger Zanon and Soderbloom.

City Manager John Archocosky, City Attorney Mark Tousignant and City Clerk Kathy Anderson also attended.

Others in attendance: Craig Richardson and Adam Steinbrecher of STS Consultants, Nancy McIntyre of Superior Reporting Service, Inc. and Reporters Wendy Shimun and Allyce Westphal.

Mayor Soderbloom opened the Public Hearing to receive public comment on the proposed sanitary sewer system improvements project, as required by Michigan Department of Quality (MDEQ) S2 State Revolving Fund (S2 SRF) loan program.

Richardson offered a power point presentation outlining the following:

- Meeting MDEQ requirements
- S2 Grant / Sewer Study Summary
- Identify system needs and /or deficiencies ranked in priority of need
- Project financing
- Impacts of proposed project
- Steps to mitigate adverse impacts
- Project timeline
- Resolution for City Council adoption

The final Project Plan has to be submitted by July 1, 2008. Project ranking by MDEQ should be available sometime in October 2008.

Steinbrecher asked the Clerk if she had received any written comments concerning the Plan and if anyone had reviewed the Project Plan placed in the Clerks office. She stated she had not received any comments.

Mayor Soderbloom closed the Public Hearing at 1:41 p.m. Beber moved to adjourn. All were in favor. Motion carried.
