Minutes**

Mayor Roger Zanon called the Public Hearing to order at 1:45 p.m. in the Council Chambers at the Iron River City Hall. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

PURPOSE OF PUBLIC HEARING: To receive public comment to close-out Michigan Economic Development Corporation (MEDC) Grant# MSC 206022-ICE – Sanitary Sewer Interceptor Replacement – Phase II.

Craig Richardson of AECOM gave a recap of the project. All work on the project has been completed. MEDC requires a public hearing be conducted to close-out the grant project. To help reduce Inflow and Infiltration (I/I), the project included 2,945 feet of 18” interceptor pipe replacement and 400 feet of collection pipe replacement along the Iron River, from 4th Avenue to 14th Avenue. I/I was discussed. Although Richardson has no statistics, he is confident that I/I is down. He also noted MEDC was pleased in the manner the project requirements were completed.

There was no Public Comment.

Coates moved to adjourn at 1:56 p.m. Marcell seconded. All in favor. Motion carried.
