MINUTES

Mayor Roger Zanon called the meeting to order at 10 a.m., in the Council Chambers at the Iron River City Hall.

Roll Call: Thomas King, Michael Brozak, Ray Coates, Edward Marcell, Zanon.

Also present: Manager John Archocosky, Treasurer Suzanne Johnson and Clerk Kathy Anderson.

The purpose of the meeting: Discuss the proposed 2010-2011 Budget and employee retirement request.

BUDGET WORKSHOP

Treasurer Johnson provided a draft of the 2010-2011 Budget. Discussion followed on the cost for benefits. Replacement of roof at the Chamber of Commerce building was discussed.

At the last Regular meeting, a Public Hearing was scheduled for May 19, 2010, to hear comments on the proposed budget.

RETIREMENT WINDOW

Department of Public Works employee Robert Dobson has requested to retire in June 2010. Archocosky recommends opening a 60 day "window" which will allow persons aged 55 with 20 years of service to retire. Municipal Employees' Retirement System of Michigan (MERS) requires a Resolution is adopted.

Brozak moved adopt a Resolution (see attached), which will open a "60" day window, from May 1, 2010, through June 30, 2010, for any eligible employee aged 55 and with 20 years of service to retire Coates seconded.

King moved to adjourn at 10:40 a.m. All were in favor. Motion carried.
