Minutes**

Mayor Roger Zanon called the Public Hearing to order at 1:45 p.m. in the Council Chambers at the Iron River City Hall.

**PURPOSE OF PUBLIC HEARING:** To receive public comment on the submission of a CDBG application for Lay Avenue Infrastructure Improvements Project.

Craig Richardson of AECOM gave a brief history of the Lay Avenue Infrastructure Improvements Project. A grant in the amount of \$350,000 has been awarded for the project from the Michigan Economic Development Corporation, through the CDBG program. The Michigan Department of Transportation Local Task Force has pledged \$210,000. The City of Iron River has pledged \$150,000. The project will include street lighting improvements, as well as the resurfacing Lay Avenue. Curbing and sidewalks from Highway US-2 to Evergreen Street will be replaced.

Marcell moved to close the Public Hearing at 1:50 p.m. Zanon seconded, as no public comment was received. All were in favor. Motion carried.
