

**CITY OF IRON RIVER
SNOW REMOVAL NOTICE**

Please be advised that snow, ice, or other material accumulations on private property resulting from removal by the property owner or occupant are not the responsibility of the city, but may be removed or caused to be removed by the city if any pedestrian or traffic safety hazards are caused by the accumulations. It shall be the duty of the Public Works Superintendent of the city to cause all removal of the accumulations from the land and the Public Works Superintendent of the city shall keep an accurate account of the expenses incurred in so doing with respect to each parcel of land entered upon for the purpose and shall make a sworn statement of the account and deliver the statement to the City Clerk. The City Clerk shall present all the accounts to the City Council not later than the third Thursday in March of each year in which the labor was performed. The City Council shall audit and, if correct, allow the accounts and order the accounts paid from the General Fund of the city. The sworn statement of the Public Works Superintendent shall give the date or dates when the removal of accumulations took place, the owner and description of the lands involved, and the costs of the labor.
