

**IRON RIVER CITY COUNCIL**

**Minutes**

Deputy Mayor Rodney Dood called the meeting to order at 4:30 p.m., in the Council Chambers of the Iron River City Hall.

**OPEN PUBLIC HEARING:** The purpose of this Public Hearing was on a request from Shane and Alyssa Marheine for the abandonment and vacating of: Ironwood Street, Singler Street, Long Street, Valley Street, and the alleys running East-West along North side of Blocks 1, and 3, and running East-West through Block 2 and running East-West on the South side of Blocks 4 and 5 all in the Plat of Carlson's Maple Valley Addition to the Village (now City) of Iron River.


**PUBLIC COMMENT:** Shane Marheine stated they wanted to build their home on the side of the field. He said the lots are large enough to build a house, but his concern was how to run his septic lines without the abandonment.

**COUNCIL MEMBER COMMENTS:** Leonoff stated building the home would benefit the City by generating more tax revenue.

Tousignant stated the abandonment is for the alleys and streets only, it will not do away with the plat, which would be a separate matter.
