Call to Order – Mayor Dennis Powell called the meeting to order at 9:30 a.m. and the Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

OLD BUSINESS

Homer Road Resurfacing Project – Funding Request:

Andreski presented a recap of funding for the Homer Road Project. If this project is to move forward, the City will need to contribute a total of \$214,996. Andreski is awaiting a return call from Doug Tomasoski (Iron County Road Commission) for the possibility of \$25,000 funding from local Category Funds.

Garcia moved with support from A. Clements to approve the total City match of \$214,996 if in the event the City does not get the extra Category Funding amount of \$25,000. The City has given a deadline of Tuesday, April 6, 2021 for notification on the extra funding.

NEW BUSINESS

Holder Tractor Repairs:

Andreski said the Holder Tractor that was purchased from a third party is in need of additional repairs. A timing issue has caused more trouble with the engine and a quotation for three different options to rebuild the motor was received.

On the recommendation of R. Clements and Andreski, Garcia moved with support from A. Clements to accept the quoted option of \$6,620 with additional charges of \$2,550 for labor and \$300 for oil and filters to rebuilding the Holder engine.
