Call to Order – Mayor Dennis Powell called the meeting to order at 9:13 a.m. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS

2021 International Snowplow Truck:

Andreski said the representative from International provided an updated quote from July 21st. She said he is confident the City should have the truck by January 1, 2022 depending on the parts and accessories ordered to go with it. She said they had received the model wanted and it was not spoken for yet. She said steel prices are on the rise and the quote already has a \$700 surcharge included, and beginning September 1st, that amount will rise. She said this is a firm quote and the difference in funding quotes from Rural Development compared to local banks is very minimal. We would be required to pay for bonding which was \$3,500 when we purchased the street sweeper. She said the Motor Pool Fund could support the approximate \$38,400 payment per year for five years.

Dood moved with support Leonoff to go forth with the purchase of the 2021 HV507 International Plow Truck from Monroe Truck Equipment for an amount of \$162,782.
