Minutes**

Mayor Dennis Powell called the meeting to order at 10:31 a.m., in the Council Chambers of the Iron River City Hall. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Roll Call: Rodney Dood, Benjamin Garcia, and Powell.

Absent: Anthony Clements and Ronjo Leonoff.

Also present: City Manager Rachel Andreski, City Clerk Bernadette Coates, and City Engineer Craig Richardson.

NEW BUSINESS

2022 Street Improvements Project

Richardson said Pandora's Box had been opened when this project began. He said the bridge deck is asphalt over dirt, over the bridge deck. When they began to pull the old curb out, the asphalt crumbled. He said there is asphalt under the whole road. He said it is in the City's best interest to remove all the concrete and fill for a good base to prepare for the new asphalt.

Dood moved with support Powell to approve \$80,000 additional funds, earmarked from the ARPA funds if needed, to remove all the old concrete and add appropriate fill.

Roll call: Ayes – 3: Garcia, Dood, and Powell. Nays – 0: Absent – 2: Clements and Leonoff.
Motion carried.

Richardson said the Chamber has agreed to pay to have their parking lot paved under the City's contract.

Andreski said the City owns the RV Park and the Chamber has agreed to pay for this improvement. The City will bill the Chamber for reimbursement. Since the equipment was going to be in the area, the project could be done much more cost effectively. It was in the bid as an alternative addition to keep track of it separately. Andreski added the Chamber would also be paying for half of the culvert replacement when that project comes up. WICKWIRE is in the design/bid process for this project now.

Dood moved with support from Garcia to approve the alternate addition to the contract to pave the Chamber's parking lot in the amount of \$11,450.

Roll call: Ayes – 3: Garcia, Dood, and Powell. Nays – 0: Absent – 2: Clements and Leonoff.
Motion carried.
